



Bringing your dogs to holiday at Exmoor Character Cottages

We love having dogs stay at all our Exmoor Character Cottages, having welcomed pooches of all colours, shapes and sizes over the years. Our dog friendly properties have everything both owner and pet will need to make it a smooth and enjoyable holiday. We know our visitors like to know what to expect before they arrive, so here's everything you need to know to ensure that you and your dog have wonderful stay!

Housekeeping

When you arrive at one our cottages you will find a dog basket or bed for your pooch as well as blankets and towels. In the gardens, there are hoses for cleaning mucky paws (we kindly ask that you do not wash your pup in any of the bathrooms or kitchens).

In return, we ask you to keep your dog off the furniture. Dogs are not allowed in the bedrooms. Any accidents should be reported straight away. It's a lot simpler for us and you if you let us know as we can take immediate action to avoid any permanent damage.

The Gardens

All our gardens have been fenced or gated to keep dogs safe in the garden. If your dog is tiny (i.e. you can hold it in your hand), please contact Lucy to discuss additional fencing.

Please ensure that you clear up after your dog and that the garden and surrounding area is left free of any trace of your dog. If we do need to clear up after your dog in the garden, you will understand that we may need to withhold some of the security deposit to cover our cleaning costs. We are big believers in biodiversity and try to keep the cottages and garden as green as we can, so we do share the gardens with frogs, hedgehogs, slow worms and birds so please do be on the lookout if your dog loves chasing wildlife!

Please note that in The Oval in Dunster, we only allow dogs from the patio up to the decked area as the garden and castle area cannot be enclosed safely.
